Boisduval Scale

Many of us like to go on the internet to look up orchid information; maybe to buy orchids, maybe for orchid care, or some of us like to join in online communities of fellow enthusiasts. I was recently doing some internet research on an insect scale pest called Boisduval Scale. Boisduval scale insects will seriously debilitate and kill an orchid if not controlled quickly. The Australian Orchid Nursery calls it 'coconut scale' because it looks like sprinkled desiccated coconut on the leaf of your orchid. I found some very helpful online resources and have included three links below. The first link is to a very readable piece by the Australian Orchid Nursery. Check out the title and take note: 'possibly the world's worst orchid pest'. Dire stuff.

The second link is to Sonoma Country Orchid Society in the USA and the article is a simple and quick read. The third link was the most detailed and informative that I found. It is an article written by Mr Paul J. Johnson Ph.D called 'Boisduval Scale on Orchids' and it was published in the American magazine 'Orchid Digest' (July, Aug, Sept) 74(3): 170-177 in 2010. The pdf article is hosted on this link to the Logan and District Orchid Society Inc. I loved that it listed off specific insecticides.

I found these articles helpful in identifying this pest and eradicating it and hope it helps you too.

May Plant of the Month

Bulbophyllum medusae

I purchased this species as a small three bulb plant 4 years ago from Cape Oasis Orchids I believe and it has just powered on. I moved it from a small pot to the basket it is in now 2 years ago with a lining of sphagnum moss and a fill of small to medium bark and perlite. It flowered last year for the first time throwing three nice flowers. This year seven buds, five progressed and opened, the other two are still at 1 inch bud size. I suspect all seven didn't flower together because of a lapse in culture maybe and the weather we had over March and April, last year it was in full flower on 11th April, this year full flower on 7th May. It is hanging in my shade house area under 50% cream shade cloth and is open to the weather so gets watered when it rains and gets morning to mid-afternoon sun through the cloth. As the new growths send out roots, I fertilise half strength Manutec 'growth' every week and change over to Manutec 'bloom' once flower buds appear. Even though the flowers only last maybe a week, they make a really lovely display.....a favourite in my collection.
