Plant of the Month by Loraine Hocking

Rhynchostylis gigantea is a species found in the humid climates of SE Asia. Laos, Thailand, Malaysia and the Phillipines.

I like to grow mine in less light than the Vandas and try to create a warm, humid growing environment with gentle air movement. I water every day in summer as well as regular misting. I water much less in winter, letting the mix dry out before the next watering.

I grow in a coarse bark mix in large plastic pots allowing the numerous aerial roots to hang free. It can be a challenge when repotting because of the very thick roots. Soaking them helps a little.

My Rhynchostylis are fertilised every week during the warmer months with Peters Cal Mag and every other week in the cooler months with Peters Flower Booster. I try and water in the mornings so that all the water is off the plants by evening.

I bring my Rhynchostylis inside once the buds have formed, where it is very light and warm as they can tend to drop buds

on the spike when the temperature becomes chilly at night. This can be very annoying when buds shrivel. There is something magical and exotic about the spicy fragrance of the Rhynchostylis. It leaves a lasting impression which I look forward to each year.

Growing Rhynchostylis can be a challenge at times but definitely worth having a go at growing this beautiful orchid. Loraine
